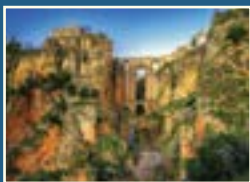

Students without Borders is an extra-curricular language programme for students of Medicine, Dentistry, Healthcare and those who are intercalating. It provides an opportunity to develop communication skills in **French** or **Spanish** at an advanced level in a clinical context. Successful completion of the programme further enhances a student's CV and could support applications to exciting opportunities, for example, an international placement. It runs for a full academic year (October to May) and is equivalent to a 20-credit undergraduate module.

The programme

Students may enter the programme during their first, second or intercalating year of study, subject to feasibility within the context of their main academic programme. There is a two-hour class each week, plus independent study. The specific focus on healthcare related vocabulary offers the opportunity to integrate advanced language skills and intercultural awareness with the student's degree programme.

As Students without Borders is extra-curricular and independent of the degree, it is not included in the fees and therefore costs £250 (please note that this is non-refundable). Failure to successfully complete the course does not impact on the student's primary degree programme.

Options

- Students who meet the entry requirement of AS level French/Spanish can enrol in Year 1, Year 2 or their Intercalating year
- Students who meet the entry requirement can refresh their skills using the resources in the Language Zone, the Rosetta Stone online language learning materials (accessed via the Virtual Learning Environment), or/and find a partner via the language exchange scheme.

Outcomes

Students who complete the programme will receive a Certificate of Successful Completion.
